Vote carefully in the next election. You can't always hear the bells.

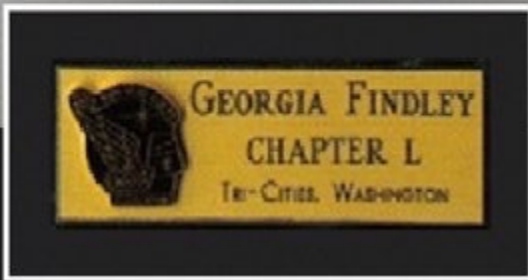
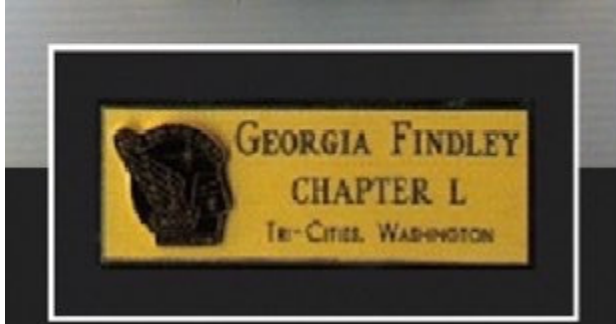
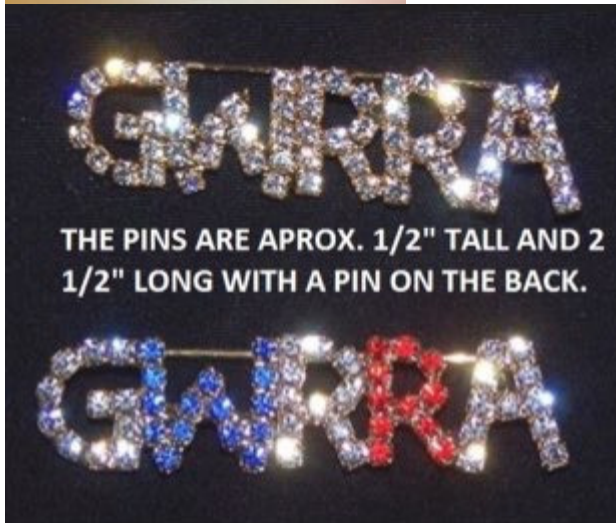
## CHAPTER STORES
