YOU MAY NEED SOME OF THESE:

I don't know about you but when I ride in cold weather, I wear my Gerbing heated jacket liner and gloves. My legs don't really get cold so I usually just wear the water repellant First Gear overplants. In the past and also most recently, my feet seem to be getting colder than I like them. It was most noticeable when riding my Honda ST-1100. My feet were really in the air path with no real protection so my toes took all the frigid air full force. The GL1500 seemed to have some pretty good wind protection so I just tuck my feet up under the cylinder heads and they don't suffer from the cold.

Well, on the GL1800 I have noticed that my feet just don't get the protection they need to stay warm. Tucking my toes up under the cylinder heads just isn't keeping them warm. I had thought about buying some Gerbing electric insoles but for some reason I always stop short of the purchase.

Now to the point I'm trying to make, I was in Costco last week and saw these toe warmers. The company that make these also make hand warmers, and foot warmers. The hand warmers and toe warmers are what I have seen available in Costco.

I picked up a box of 30 packages for \$13.99 and took them home. Each package holds two self adhesive warmers. Simply open the package, remove the paper backing and place the adhesive



side of the toe warmer on the outside of your sock, at the top or bottom of the toe area. I put them on the top of the sock over my toes. After about 20 minutes of exposure to the air, they had heated up to about 105 degrees and they maintain their temperature for about 5 hours. I can vouch for that. I left on a ride at noon with these puppies in place and after returning home from a six hour ride, I checked them with a thermometer and they read 109 degrees.

I checked the website for these little hotties at https://www.littlehottieswarmers.com/ and they are pretty proud of their product. The manufacturer sells a box of 40 on their website for \$60.00 That is about \$1.50 a package. Now, if that is the only way I could get them is to pay \$1.50 a package, I would probably buy them BUT, Costco sells a box of 30 for \$13.99. That is about \$.50 per package. Quite a savings and THEY WORK. You can find them in Costco on a shelf

near the glove displays. I really like these warmers. I'm not going to have cold toes again.
